

HOUSE SELECTION WHITE WINE

For the white wines a scale of sweetness, defined by the Wine Development Board using Numbers 1-9, has been used.

Number 1 signifies very dry wines and number 9 indicates very sweet wines.

3	Alto Pampas Viognier, Mendoza (Argentina) With apricot fruit this is full and flavoursome. (13 %)	2	£ 14.00
4	Stirling Hills Semillon/Chardonnay, (South Eastern Australia) Just the sort of wine that converted the UK to drink Australian. An eminently drinkable wine, the bouquet is fairly spicy, the fruit is Soft and the finish is crisp and dry. (12.5 %)	2	£ 15.00
5	Amanti del Vino, Pinot Grigio, Delle Venezie IGT (Italy) Pinot Grigio from northern Italy is the dry white wine of the moment! This one, from near Venice, is crisp, refreshing and Unoaked. (12 %)	1	£ 15.25

HOUSE SELECTION RED WINES

This guide uses a simple five point scale, but uses letters A-E in order to differentiate it from the white wine guide. The five categories identify red wines in terms of total taste, in other words, the impression on the palate.

Starting at A, the wines are easy, undemanding and quaffable. At E, the other end of the scale, the wines are bigger and more concentrated with a greater sensation of depth and fullness.

Citrus and lime Semillon bouncing off the rounded tropical Chardonnay. (13.5%)
- 22 (3) **Villa Romero Pinot Grigio/Garganega (Italy)** £ 4.50
A lovely off dry style, with flavours of peach and tropical fruits. (12%)
- 23 (1) **Concha y Toro Sauvignon Blanc, (Central Valley, Chile)** £ 4.50
A typically fresh, lively Sauvignon with light gooseberry aromas and flavours. (12.5%)

RED WINES

- 24 (D) **Rouges Ridge Shiraz/Cabernet, (Australia)** £ 4.50
Fruity blackberry flavours which oozes truckloads of ozzy sunshine. (14%)
- 25 (C) **Concha y Toro Merlot, (Central Valley, Chile)** £ 4.50
Bursting with cherry and ripe, red berry fruits intertwined with pepper and a touch of coffee bean. Elegant and medium-bodied. (12.5%)
- 26 (C) **Concha y Toro Cabernet Sauvignon, (Central Valley, Chile)** £ 4.50
A fruity, soft and flavoursome red. (13%)

- 27 (4) **Waters Edge Blush (California, USA)** £ 4.50
A pretty wine made with lovely, flowery fruit and a hint of blackcurrants. (11%)
